2024 / 2025 GOLF RULES & REGULATIONS:

The following Golf Rules are in effect for the golf calendar year. Wherever member is referenced in this guide, the definition applies to an Active Golf Membership.

After careful consideration of member concerns submitted to the Club, we have instituted a code of conduct for Members, Guests, and Families to protect both the golf course and those who are on it.

The following is a summary of positive, pro-active regulations developed to heighten your enjoyment of the course at Stone Canyon. Members will be held accountable for violations up to and including, suspension of privileges or termination of membership.

GOLF RULES - HIGHLIGHTED FOCUS FOR 2024 / 2025 SEASON:

- Bringing outside alcohol on property/course is expressly forbidden.
- No member or guest of a member may take range balls from any practice facility for use on the golf course.
- Any group greater than 4 players must be approved by the golf shop, before play.
- Members must put player names into groups at the time of registration.
- Members, guests, and family must follow the posted on-course cart rules.
- All Stone Canyon golf carts may only occupy up to two (2) players (maximum of Two (2) golf carts per group).
- All members, guests, and family must follow the posted dress code regulations while on the property. This is highlighted on page 29.
- Pace of play should not exceed 4 hours prior to 11:00am and 4 hours and 20 minutes after that. You are expected to keep pace with the group in front of you throughout your round of golf regardless of tee time. When necessary, a marshal will assist with helping groups keep pace throughout their round.
 - First time out of position, the group must improve pace of play within 2 holes.
 - Second time out of position, the group must pick up their ball and move up to the group in front of them.
 - Third time out of position, the group will be asked to leave the golf course.
- Respect of all members of the club and employees by members and guests is expected. Any verbal abuse or worse will be met with a zero-tolerance policy.

Tee Times Reservations:

- a) The hours of golf course play, practice range hours and Golf Shop hours will be posted in the Golf Shop and are subject to change depending on golf course and weather conditions. The Golf Course Superintendent in consultation with the Director of Golf shall determine when the golf course is playable and such decision shall be final. No golf course play shall be permitted during any period that the course is determined not fit for play. In addition, when the golf course is closed.
- b) All players must be assigned a starting time through the ForeTees App. Starting times must be reserved through the ForeTees app. All Stone Canyon members may schedule tee times fourteen (14) days in advance. On the ForeTees app, Members may reserve only 1 starting time per day (no more than 4 players) per request. If a member would like to schedule more than one time, he/she must call the golf shop.
- c) Sports Members in good standing may play up to four (4) rounds of golf at Stone Canyon per calendar year. The Sports Member will pay the designated Sports Member Guest Fee and Cart Fee for each round. Practice facilities may be enjoyed on the same day of the scheduled tee time. Sports Members may not access the golf facilities as Extended Family Members or Member Guests

- d) Family Guest policy is as follows.
 - i. Definition- Relatives of the Membership holder consist of Grandparents, Parents, Brother, Sister, Grandchildren.
 - ii. Family guests must be accompanied by their primary member to qualify for family rate.
 - iii. If a family guest is called in by the primary member to play but not accompanied by the primary member, the family guest may be subject to the unaccompanied rate.
 - iv. Family guests cannot make tee times and are not considered part of the membership. Any tee times need to be made by the primary member.
- e) All starting times shall be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis, and must be made via ForeTees. The person making the reservation will be responsible for the tee time.
- f) The golf course and practice facilities may be reserved for men's or women's play on certain days and during certain hours. Other players will be accommodated during these times on a space available basis only.
- g) Specific golf course rules & restrictions are applied and published periodically and are available in the Golf Shop

Check In / Registration:

All member's guests must register in the Golf Shop before beginning play. Members are responsible for the payment of all cart and guest fees before beginning play. If guests do not come in and pay for their round, the rounds will be charged to the accompanying member's account.

All play starts on hole number one (1) unless permission to the contrary is obtained from the Golf Professional Staff or is indicated on the ForeTees daily tee sheet.

- c) Scorecards for tournament play at Stone Canyon must be completed, signed, attested to by the opposing player(s), and turned into the Stone Canyon golf shop immediately after completion of your round for verification. Golf Genius will be used as a form of live scoring only and will not be used to determine official scoring. If there are any discrepancies between scorecards and Golf Genius, the written scorecard shall be used.
- d) The entry fee for an event is subject to change depending on selection and cost of any food items, gifts, etc.
- e) Cancellations that occur after a deadline are responsible for entry fee which covers food, tee gifts, and prizes.
- *f*) If an event or league does not exceed the minimum amount of participation, the Director of Golf has the discretion to cancel the event and open the tee sheet for regular play.
- g) Except for the Men's Member-Guest Tournament, entries are on a first come first serve basis. If a tournament is over-subscribed, entries will be placed on a waiting list in the order they are received.
- h) All tournament participants must have an established AGA/ USGA handicap index through Stone Canyon, unless the format of a given tournament allows for non-handicap participation.
- i) The Director of Golf and the Club has the right to modify the format of an event.
- j) The Stone Canyon Golf Professional Staff determines the Handicap Revision Dates for each Event.
- *k)* No golf tournaments of any kind or play by any group of five (5) or more persons, shall be permitted unless approved in advance by the Golf Professional. Staff.

Tournament Awards

After each Tournament, the winners' credit amounts will be entered into the credit book. Thereafter, when a member makes a merchandise purchase and requests to use the credit dollars, it is subtracted from the amount in the credit book.

Rules of Play

- USGA rules will govern all play in conjunction with Stone Canyon's local rules.
- All disputes will be settled by the Director of Golf and/or the Golf Committee whose decision will be final.
- ➤ The maximum handicap index that can be allocated to a golfer is 36, unless otherwise noted by the Golf Committee.

Ties:

Unless a playoff is specified in the rules of a Tournament, ties will be broken by a scorecard playoff. The USGA recommended procedure of matching cards is as follows: the winner will be determined based on best total score for the last nine holes. If a tie remains, the winner

will be determined based on the last six holes, the last three holes, and finally the 18th hole if necessary. If a tie still exists after following this method, the match of scorecards will go to the number one handicap hole and proceed until a winner is determined.

Golf Cart Use & Walking

- *a)* The use of golf carts on the golf course may be mandatory for all players during certain Tournaments.
- b) Golf carts are restricted to use on the golf course and practice areas. No golf carts shall be removed from the Club Facilities at any time without prior approval of the Golf Professional Staff.
- c) Golf carts shall be operated only by persons sixteen (16) years of age or older with a valid automobile driver's license.
- d) No more than two (2) persons are permitted on a standard golf cart, except in case of emergency, course evacuation or at the discretion of the Golf Shop.
- e) Golf carts shall remain on cart paths on all par 3's and whenever else possible. Golf carts shall not be driven within fifteen (15) yards of any tee, bunker, or penalty area and thirty (30) yards from any green. Golf carts should be driven across fairways only at right angles, avoiding soft areas. Golf carts are not to be driven into the desert at any time. Golf carts are to be parked on the cart path prior to putting or teeing on all greens and tees, golf cart traffic and directional signage must be always obeyed.
- f) Golf carts are operated at the risk of the operator. The cost of repairing any damage to golf carts or the golf course resulting from improper operation will be charged to the Member in whose name the operator is playing at the time the damage occurs.

Walking:

Walking, whether carrying or pushing your clubs, is permitted at any time. We ask that you be courteous of your fellow competitors during competition as to be very aware of your pace of play. The Professional staff has the right to mandate carts for certain events to maintain the appropriate pace of play and enjoyment of all playing.

Pace of Play:

- ▶ All players are to maintain a reasonable pace of play. Specifically,
 - a. An 18-hole round of golf should be completed in no more than 4 hours when teeing off prior to 11:00am and no more than 4 hours and 20 minutes When teeing off after 11:00am.
 - b. Players are encouraged to play "ready golf". If feasible, twosomes should join to form a foursome. The goal is to maintain pace with the group in front, not staying ahead of the group behind. Pace of play is a matter of golf etiquette and courtesy to other Members.
 - c. If your group is off pace and out of position, the Golf Staff has the right to inform the group and ask them to speed up. Your group may be asked to let players play through or be instructed to pick up their balls and proceed to the next tee after two warnings, no questions asked.

Stone Canyon is making a major effort to combat golf's greatest problem – SLOW PLAY. We believe that a round of golf should take no longer than 4 hours to complete.

Pace of Play Tips:

- ➤ Always play ready golf
- ➤ Be aware of your handicap and the maximum number of strokes you can take, pick up when the max is reached.
- Arrive at the first tee 5 minutes prior to your tee time.
- Always keep pace with the group in front of you



Guests:

- ➤ All Guests are subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Club, including the pace of play rules. Members are responsible for their Guests' activities and behavior at all times, even when not in the accompanied foursome.
- Only 1 guest per member prior to 11:00am Friday thru Sunday
- All guests <u>must</u> check in with the golf shop prior to playing.

Equipment, Dress Code

- Every player must have a set of golf clubs. No sharing of golf clubs shall be permitted.
- For those who do not have their own clubs, rental sets can be purchased in the golf shop.

Dress Code: Golf Course

Proper club attire is required of all Members and Guests. Men must wear shirts with collars, progressive collars, mock necks or turtlenecks, and sleeves. Proper attire for women is golf or dress shorts, slacks, or skirts. Collarless shirts must have sleeves and sleeveless shirts must have collars.

If you choose to wear a hat while playing, we require that it be worn with the bill facing forward.

Clothing items that are **not** permitted are as follows: jeans, denim, t-shirts, tank tops, cutoffs, sweatpants, basketball shorts, swimsuits, and anything deemed not appropriate by the golf shop.

Dress Code: Clubhouse:

Proper club attire is required of all Members and Guests. Men must wear shirts with collars, progressive collars, mock necks or turtlenecks, and sleeves. Golf or walking shorts, slacks, and skirts (for women) are considered proper attire. Jeans are permitted inside the clubhouse, provided they are clean, presentable, and deemed appropriate by Club Management. Golf caps are permitted inside the clubhouse before 5:00 p.m. but must be worn with the bill facing forward. Men may not wear hats or caps after 5:00 p.m. inside the clubhouse; however, hats or caps are permitted on the outdoor patios.

T-shirts, tank tops, inappropriate jeans, cutoffs, sweatpants, athletic shorts. Bathing suits, clothing marked with offensive language or a degrading message, or clothing that is torn or ripped or other attire deemed inappropriate by Club Management are not permitted.

Golf Course Play

- Jogging, bicycling, walking, skateboarding, walking of dogs, etc. are not permitted on the golf course or cart paths after 8:00am in season and after 7:00am during the summer.
- All play shall start at hole number one unless permission to start elsewhere is obtained in advance from the Golf Shop.
- If play is involuntarily discontinued due to weather or closing of the course by the Golf Professional Staff, players will be issued a credit for golf charges based on how many holes were played.
- Practice is restricted to designated practice areas.
- All players shall repair ball marks on greens and replace divots and smooth sand traps before moving to the next tee.





- Players stopping between nines must obtain permission from the Golf Shop to resume play.
- The rules of golf adopted by the United States Golf Association shall govern all play, except as modified by the local rules set forth herein.
- Players shall observe appropriate golf etiquette at all times.

Driving Range Rules:

- The practice range is to be used only by Members and their Guests (who are playing that day), as well as by Sports Members immediately prior to their tee time.
- Range balls are not to be removed from the driving range.
- Members and Guests will observe all special rules concerning use of the practice range posted from time to time, including rules regarding the location of specific areas where practice may be temporarily prohibited, and hours of operation.
- Golf attire is always required while using the practice range.



Hole in One Club:


If you would like to sign up, you must do so in the golf shop.

Qualifying Hole in One:

- Must be at Stone Canyon
- Must be on your first shot, mulligans do not count.
- Must be during a post-able round of golf (at least 7 holes played)
- Must be witnessed by at least one person.

Storm / Bad Weather:

When dangerous weather approaches, all players are asked to exit the golf course and come into the clubhouse for safety. Should you choose to remain on the golf course, you are doing so at your own risk.



Stone Canyon Local Rules Sheet

Desert Rule - If your ball has been hit into the desert, you may treat it as a Red Penalty Area. The desert is defined by where the grass on the golf course ends, and the desert begins. This includes all rock outcroppings inside the fairway and rough. If there is a cart path between the edge of the grass and the edge of the desert, the desert begins at the edge of the cart path and the edge of the desert. Should the cart path be surrounded by desert on both sides, the cart path is deemed to be inside the penalty area and there is no relief from that cart path in this situation. The washes on holes two (2), twelve (12), and fifteen (15) are to be played by the same rule. Relief is the same as a Lateral (Red) Penalty Area. USGA Rule 17.

Drop Zones: Drop zones will always be marked for Tournament play. They are marked by a white circle, with DZ, painted inside the circle.

Penalty Areas: All penalty areas will be defined by either a red line or a set of stakes. Please make sure to follow the USGA rule (Rule 17),

Stones in Bunkers: Stones in bunkers are moveable obstructions, you are allowed to move them.

Greenside Sprinklers: A player may take one club relief no nearer the hole and not on the green from a greenside sprinkler if the following conditions are met: a) the ball lies off the green, but not in a Penalty Area. b) The sprinkler is within two club lengths of the green or on the green and the ball lies within two club lengths of the sprinkler. c) The sprinkler intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole.
